

Car Raffle Raises \$58,000 for Bosque School Athletics and Financial Aid

On Friday, April 27, Roland Diefenthaler, of Arizona, was the lucky winner of a new 2007 Pontiac G6 Convertible donated by Pitre Buick/GMC/Pontiac and Jim and Mary Brown of Albuquerque were the lucky winners of the Hewlett Packard Notebook package donated by Computer Corner.

As part of a five year pledge to the school, Bob Pitre, owner of Pitre Buick/GMC/Pontiac, has donated a total of six vehicles to the school to raise money for athletics and financial aid. This year's car, the Pontiac G6 was worth \$30,000. The raffle had additional support from Carole Petranovich of Computer Corner with the donation of a Hewlett Packard Notebook package valued at \$1,000 as a second place prize.

A total of 651 tickets were sold raising \$58,000 to support academic life at Bosque School. Tickets were purchased from individuals in New Mexico and around the country. The official drawing for the 2007 Pontiac G6 and HP Notebook took place at the Bosque School Spring Fling on Friday, April 27. Jake Dopson, a certified public accountant with Pulakos & Alongi, Ltd., certified the drawing by accounting for all tickets sold and unsold. Dopson and Margaret Gaspar of Computer Corner pulled the winning tickets from the barrel and emcee, Billy Widner, President of the Albuquerque Thunderbirds announced the winner. There were over 600 people in attendance for the Spring Fling.
