

# CAMPUS ADDITIONS

## **GOAL FOUR:** *Continue to build the campus.*

### **BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE:**

Bosque's campus is beautiful, it is functional, it is even remarkable considering that it is only seven years old, but it is not complete. There is still work to be done. Even given the commitment to remain a small school, over the next five years Bosque will need additional classrooms, first-class science facilities, additional athletic facilities, additional administrative, library, and technology space, and improved parking and landscaping, to name only the obvious.

Bosque now has almost twice the acreage that it had in 2000 when the school moved to the present location. Not all of this land is available to build on, however, and even if it were, careful planning would be required to prioritize the needs and to place the new buildings and facilities in the most optimum locations. While funds may not be available to accomplish all that is desired, the necessary planning can begin and may even have the additional benefit of stimulating the interest of potential donors.

### **TO ACHIEVE GOAL FOUR, BOSQUE WILL:**

- Determine what buildings and facilities are necessary to complete the campus and prioritize those needs.
- Develop a projected cost for each building and facility deemed necessary to complete the campus, including the anticipated cost of operating the building or facility once completed.
- With the assistance of professional planners, produce a campus master plan that includes a model that can be used by the board to aid in its decisions.
- Begin the design of the next new building.
